



UNIFORM POLICY REMINDER:

As per School Board Policy 5511, to promote a safe and supportive environment and improve school safety and discipline, all students in K-8 schools shall participate in a mandatory uniform program. For Pinecrest Elementary, the uniform for 2016-2017 consists of:

Navy blue or khaki colored pants, skirts, skorts, shorts or Bermuda shorts. Blue jeans are NOT acceptable (unless they are designated "jean" days for a specific activity). The shirt colors are white, red, navy blue, light blue and pink. All tops are to have the Pinecrest school patch. These patches are available at AA Uniforms and at the school store. You may purchase your school uniform clothing from a variety of stores, including our school store.

During cold weather days, students may wear navy blue sweat pants instead. Girls may wear leggings or tights ONLY if worn underneath the uniform skirt, skort, or shorts. NO other bottoms will be accepted.

As a safety precaution, closed toe shoes provide better protection and support for the child's feet. It is requested that sandals NOT be worn. A closed shoe MUST be worn for all physical education activities. Large metal taps, metal cleats or wheels on shoes may not be worn. Skirts, skorts and shorts must be long enough to cover until the child's finger tips when standing straight. No hats or headscarves may be worn in the school building. Accessories that cause distraction or detract from uniform expectations may be denied.

In addition, Zuca rolling bookbags are a tripping and safety hazard. Therefore, these are not allowed.

If any student violates the uniform policy, it will be documented on a Student Case Management Form as a referral because it is a violation of the Code of Student Conduct.
